The Preliminary Proceedings Committee (the "PPC") met on 24 January 2020 and formally assigned your complaint to me in my role as Case Officer. The PPC directed that I carry out the following investigations in relation to your complaint.

- a) Invite Dr Dominic Harmon to provide the PPC with any information he believes should be considered pursuant to section 59(6) of the Medical Practitioners Act 2007.

(In the event that Dr Dominic Harmon does not provide a response within a reasonable time period of the outcome of the PPC meeting being notified to him, issue a notice pursuant to section 59(7) of the Medical Practitioners Act 2007 to Dr Dominic Harmon requiring him to provide such information to the PPC.)

When the above investigations have been carried out, all information obtained during the course of the investigation will be sent to so that he can supply to the PPC any information that he believes should be considered. All of the information will then be considered by the PPC and it can form an opinion regarding your complaint or direct further investigations be carried out.
