

Formal Escalation Note

Subject: Escalation — Rights-Based Exclusion from PRI Reporting Platform — UN Oversight Requested (Ticket #893)

5 August 2025

Dear colleagues,

I am writing to formally escalate an ongoing case of rights-based exclusion from the PRI Reporting Tool, following my registration as an independent human rights defender and ESG accountability campaigner.

Despite completing registration and attempting login via PRI's official platform, access was denied without explanation. I then submitted documented evidence and a formal escalation — resulting in Ticket #893: Reporting.

The response I received from PRI staff confirmed that only "signatory" organisations are permitted access to the Reporting Tool — thereby excluding independent rights defenders, journalists, and individuals seeking to submit evidence of ESG harm, investor risk, or regulatory failure.

This constitutes a structural obstruction to remedy and transparency, in direct contradiction to the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs), and to the PRI's stated commitment to responsible investment and accountability.

This exclusion occurs despite:

- My protected status under the UN Declaration on Human Rights Defenders (1998)
- A live UN case file on institutional obstruction and redress denial (Ref: URUST/2025/ONN/72)

- Evidence of harm involving suppressed child mortality data, rights violations, and ESG reporting failures (see Oversight Archive link below)

I respectfully request that this matter be reviewed by:

- The UN Working Group on Business and Human Rights
- The UN Special Rapporteur on Human Rights Defenders
- The OHCHR B-Tech Project (re: digital access and transparency frameworks)
- Relevant PRI governance officials and legal oversight channels

It is critical that non-signatory defenders are not excluded from reporting ESG risk and human rights harm, especially when evidence is already before international oversight.
